CHSAA Hall of Fame Nomination Criteria

All CHSAA Hall of Fame nominees must meet the following criteria to be eligible for selection. The CHSAA Hall of Fame Selection/Recognition Committee may waive any criterion if it believes that the person or category could not be adequately represented by the established criteria.

General Criteria

- 1. The nominee must have been involved with a CHSAA-sanctioned activity in a Colorado high school for the specified number of years in the category for which he or she is nominated.
- 2. The nominee must have demonstrated outstanding abilities and contributions in the category for which nominated.
- 3. The nominee must have demonstrated high moral character, outstanding citizenship and the ideals embodied in the CHSAA Code of Ethics.

Specific Criteria

The following definitions and criteria shall apply to the five nominating categories. Note that categories are for grouping purposes. There are no quotas for each category. *Please note: The nominee must be retired from the following categories in which he/she has been nominated.* (Effective for nominations received after February 15, 1994.)

Student\Participant

A high school graduate who participated for a minimum of two seasons in a CHSAA-sanctioned activity. The nominee may not be considered until 10 years after high school graduation.

Coach/Sponsor

An employee of a Colorado school district who has acted as coach, sponsor or director of a sanctioned activity for a **minimum of 15 years.** (The committee may consider waiving the 15-year requirement for nominees in activities sanctioned for a limited time by the CHSAA.)

Administrator

An employee of a Colorado school district, or CHSAA member school, who has acted as an activities director, athletic director, principal, assistant principal, assistant superintendent or superintendent for a minimum of 15 years.

Official/Judge

An official who has been registered with the CHSAA for a **minimum of 15 years.** (See note above on 15-year waiver.)

Significant Service

A person nominated in the Significant Service category is a person who has made significant contributions of any kind to Colorado high school activities at the state level. He or she may not fit under the categories above, but has made the personal sacrifices to better high school activities for Colorado's students. There is no minimum years service requirement.
