

Create a Leadership Portrait

Materials Needed

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- Construction Paper
- Paints
- Yarn
- Poster Board

Task

- 1 Draw a poster size portrait of yourself. Include the following in each body part:
 - Mouth: A quote that describes you
 - Eyes: the vision you want to accomplish in Stuco this year
 - Ears: What you hear from the student body and what our school needs to do to improve
 - Heart: Name the one thing you want to do to make a difference in your relationships with others
 - Mind: State the focus area of what you will try to work on to make our school more connected
 - Top of the head: What mark or legacy do you wish to leave upon your graduation? What will your best accomplishment be?
 - Hand: List 5 areas of your personality of which you are most proud
 - Foot: What are the two things you want to “stamp out” on campus
 - Arm: What do you love most about being in Stuco
 - Leg: What area have “walked away” from in Stuco and need to get back to in the future
- 2 Present your poster on the due date. Be sure to neatly type your responses and paste them on or near the assigned body part. Explain each of the 10 parts you have used when presenting your poster.
- 3 Decorate your poster to make it look like you. Add yarn for hair, fabric for clothes, etc.

Rubric

- Portrait is turned in on due date 10 points
- All 10 attributes are addressed and labeled on portrait 40 points
- Speech is clear, concise, and engaging 10 points
