- Arrive at Summer Camp on Sunday July 15, to set up and for training.
- Must attend State Camp July 16-19, 2018.
- Must attend the fall, winter and spring meetings as scheduled.
- Must attend Fall Conference at Arvada West on October 12-13 and arrive on October 11.
- Must prepare and present a roundtable discussion at Fall Conference.

****If a candidate cannot commit to these meetings and Camps/Conference they will not be able to serve on the board.****

PLEASE READ AND UNDERSTAND: Responsibilities of the Board Member's School & Advisor

- High Schools are financially responsible for all expenses associated with the office including, but not limited to, travel, lodging, and registration for State Leadership Conference at Arvada West.
- Advisor is responsible for accompanying their student the day before State Conference or ensuring that the student's parent will accompany them to Fall Conference on Thursday, October 11.
- School or Advisor is also responsible for lodging for the extra day at Conference. Board Members will not be permitted to drive off site while attending any CHSAA function.
