

2017 T&F OFFICIALS ON-LINE RULES TEST

The 2017 T&F Rules Test must be taken on-line by all officials. The test window will OPEN January 28, 2017 on ARBITER at 5:00 p.m. The 100 question on-line test will close February 28, 2017 at NOON.

ARBITER is now open for you to register (once your dues are paid). CHSAA requires you to register on this site yearly once you have paid your dues. It is highly recommended that you do not wait until the last minute to register.

NOTE: Prior to taking your on-line test, you must do the following:

- Prior to June 30, 2016, you may pay your dues to Monica Tillman at CHSAA in the amount of \$50.00.
- Dues paid after this date will be \$60.00. Please make your check out to the “CTFOA”.
- Once Monica receives your check, she will open up the registration process for you on ARBITER.
- Register (or re-register) on ARBITER and update your information.
- If you are in need of a “background check” or need to update your background check, you may do this on ARBITER. Your background check is good for three years.
- Attend one of the Master Rules Clinics for officials at the CHSCA (Colorado High School Coaches Association) in Aurora, Colorado. There are two clinics being offered in an attempt to accommodate as many officials as possible at this one site.
 - Jan. 27, 2017 6:00 - 8:30 p.m. in the Spruce Room (Lower Level)
 - Jan. 28, 2017 1:30 – 4:00 p.m. in the Spruce Room (Lower Level)
 - Radisson Hotel Denver Southeast

 - Aurora, Co. 720-857-9000
- NOTE: If you are unable to attend one of the two Master Rules Clinics in Aurora, you may attend one of the **Satellite Clinics** that have been schedule for officials around the state. You may view the Satellite Clinics that are being offered in your area by going to the [CHSAANOW](#) website and arrow over to CHSAA.ORG and arrow down and click on “officials”. Arrow to Sports on the left side of the screen and click on T&F. Then click on Track & Field Satellite Clinics under the heading “Current Info”.
- Attending a Rules Clinic specifically for coaches will not count toward becoming a certified official.
