2018 CHSAA State Championships Nordic Details

Nordic Details Location: Tennessee Pass Nordic Center – At the base of Ski Cooper on Tennessee Pass, off US Highway 24 between Redcliff and Leadville

Entries: Qualified skiers will be entered automatically. All “bye to state” skiers and known scratches must be sent to Karl Remsen by Monday, February 19th at 12:00 pm (although earlier is better!).

Entry Fee: \$20.00 per skier per race

Classic Race: 5:00 to 7:00 pm on Wednesday, February 21st at Lake County High School or

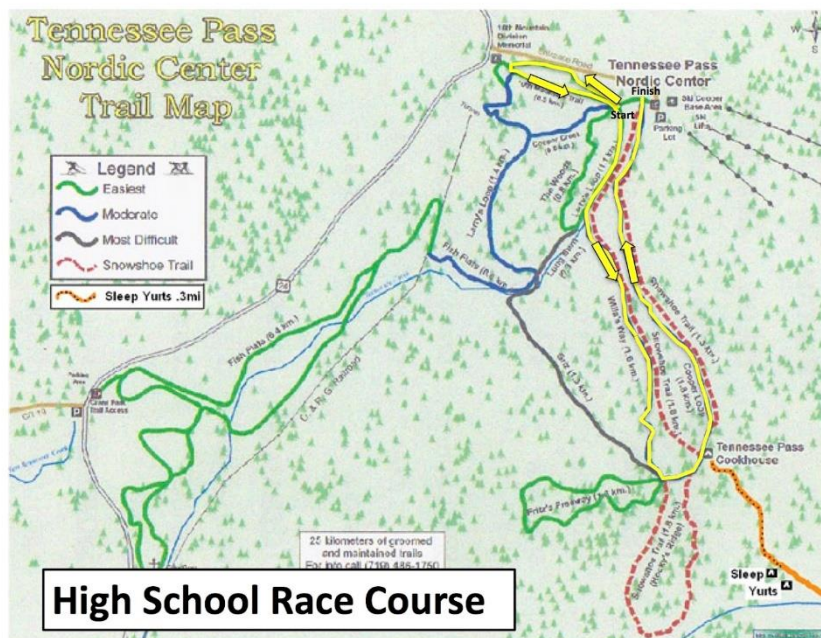
7:30 to 8:30 am on Thursday, February 22nd on the 2nd floor of the Tennessee Pass Nordic Center

Skate Race: 1:00 to 2:30 pm on Friday, February 23rd on the 2nd floor of the Tennessee Pass Nordic Center

Seeds: Racers will be seeded in the classic race by their best two regular season races by using all-state points. Racers in the skate race will be seeded based off their finish from the previous day in the classic race. Any skier who is more than 6 minutes behind the leader will start together in a wave start. Any skier who is only participating in the skate race will be seeded in the wave start based off of their two best regular season finishes.

Track/Course Notes:

Both races will run on the same course. It will start at the base of the meadow. It will go out Larry’s to the west, return up 10th Mountain, back onto Larry’s, then up Willa’s, then up to Cookhouse and down Cooper Loop. Warm up for the races can be done on Cooper Creek or on The Woods.



Buildings: The Tennessee Pass Nordic Center is small and is not a place for a team to set up camp. They are excited to host the race and have a full menu of food for parents and racers. The best place to have your kids hang out and leave their stuff is in the Ski Cooper base lodge, which is a 3-minute walk away. There are larger bathrooms located in the Ski Cooper base lodge, as well.

Waxing: Should you need, you can set up wax benches and/or tents in the field below the Nordic center or in the vicinity of the Nordic center. There is power located on outside of the Nordic center.

Parking: Ski Cooper employees will direct you where to park. Please follow their directions. Anywhere you park in the Ski Cooper lot is only a few minutes walk to the Nordic center or Ski Cooper base lodge.
