no uniforms, coaches, school dollars and/or school transportation. Principal must sign off academically.

May a track participant compete in non-school events during the season?

- **A. Yes, with written permission of the principal prior to that participation and under the stipulations of Outside Competition Rule.**

Cont. Q & A

Do those events count against the contest limits established by the CHSAA?

- **A. No- but they can not represent their school in any way**

At what point does an 8th grade student become eligible to participate with high school underclassman at a school sponsored activity (i.e. camps, weight room, off-season workouts, etc.

- **A. Starting May 1st. They must have preregistered or live in the attendance area of the high school in which they will participate.**

Qualifying Meets

- ▶ Pre-Meet meeting
- ▶ Officials and coaches are responsible for the experience for athletes. Qualified people running the events.
- ▶ Forms- Sign offs
- ▶ Qualifying meets on the website/under tabs.
 - ▶ Higher standard

Major Changes For Track and Informational Items

- ▶ **Track No major changes from 2016**
 - ▶ Committee will meet February @ 9:00am at the CHSAA office
 - ▶ Timing of changes
 - ▶ Looking to move to the Friday prior to the clinic.
- ▶ **Certified officials – Four for track in all qualifying meets.(1-Referee, 1-Head Field Referee, 1-Starter, 1-Clerk of Course) at all meets. It is suggested that If your meets have 6 or more teams it is suggested to have 2-Starters.**
- ▶ **Time Schedules- on the website – We are seeing and hearing suggestions, but we are waiting until we have gone through the entire cycle and everyone has had a chance to experience.**
