First Team Criteria: (school issued)

1-3.60 or higher cumulative GPA

2-minimum junior in school

3-must be a letter winner or equivalent in activity nominated

4-must be a participant in a CHSAA sanctioned activity during current season

(Note: Cumulative GPA's through the Fall Semester will be used for Winter & Spring. Cumulative GPA's through the Spring Semester will be used for Fall.) (Note: A student may be named in each activity season.)

Honorable Mention: (school issued)

1-3.30 to 3.59 cumulative GPA

2-minimum junior academic standing

3-must be a letter winner or equivalent in activity nominated

4-must be a participant in a CHSAA-sponsored activity during current season

(Note: Cumulative GPA's through the Fall Semester will be used for Winter & Spring. Cumulative GPA's through the Spring Semester will be used for Fall.) (Note: A student may be named in each activity season.)

IBM Heroes

IBM/850 KOA/Denver Broncos have teamed with CHSAA to recognize activity/athletic participants, coaches, administrators, officials and volunteers that promote the educational value of interscholastic participation. Dairy MAX Colorado Spirit Award

We are proud and honored to present our member schools with scholarship opportunities through the generosity of our partnership with Dairy MAX Colorado Spirit Award. The following criteria is the eligibility and nomination process for student-participants who would like to be considered for the Dairy MAX Colorado Spirit Award/Scholarship recipients. Four student participants will be selected for scholarship awards. Three

- \$1,000 scholarships – one overall All-Star will receive a \$2,500 scholarship. The primary criteria for selection is the student-participant's leadership qualities within and outside of the school. Each school

nominates a student to represent the Dairy MAX Colorado Spirit Award. They must have the

following: Senior, 2.5 or higher GPA, a list of CHSAA sanctioned athletic, activity and/or additional

clubs/organizations in which student is involved and a list any community service outreaches/or projects centered around the Great American Milk Drive. **Application:** Dairy MAX Colorado Spirit Award Nomination Form; Minimum of one letter for recommendation. Winners will be notified and invited to the CHSAA Hall of Fame Banquet on April 23, 2019 for the presentation of awards. Les Schwab Tire Centers Academic Team Championship Award

Submit your team's information to be eligible for the Les Schwab Academic Team Championship Award. All student-athletes listed will receive a certificate. The team with the **highest** GPA will receive certificates and pins.

Criteria

1. Varsity team must have a **3.50** cumulative or higher GPA. Freshman use current GPA to date.
2. All varsity team members that participate in **75% or more** of the season must be figured into team GPA. Team members whose participation in the season is **below 75% cannot** be figured into the team GPA.
3. Varsity boys' and girls' teams must be figured separately.
4. Only **varsity** team members GPA's can be used. No managers, team attendants, lower levels, or trainers.
5. Only **unweighted** GPA's may be used.

3 & 4-Sport Participation Awards

The CHSAA 3 & 4-Sport Participation Awards recognize outstanding student-athletes who have participated, at any level, in three or four different sports during one academic school year. Any student-athlete who has achieved either of these feats is eligible to receive the 3 or 4-sport award. If your school has qualifying students and is in need of certificates, the school athletic director must complete and submit the form on **Arbiter Athlete (www.arbiterathlete.com)** by March 29th. Upon receipt of Arbiter Athlete form, certificates will be sent to your school. We encourage you to complete these certificates and then present them to your student-athletes during an all-school assembly.

CHSAA Active Scholar

The CHSAA and the Colorado Rockies partner to “Rock the Rock Pile” in June. Each school nominates one-boy and one-girl to represent an Active scholar. School representatives are given a certificate and the program pays for their ticket to attend the designated Rockies game. From all the application forms one-boy and one-girl is selected to represent the scholars with an On-Field “Rockies” ceremony and presentation of their \$1,000.00 scholarship. Schools use their discretion when submitting their nominees.
